<p>4 <i>Then I will give you rains in their season, and the land will yield her produce, and the trees of the field will yield their fruit.</i></p> <p>5 Your threshing will last until the vintage, and your vintage will last until sowing time. You will eat your fruit to the full, <b>and you will live securely in the land.</b></p> <p>6 <b>And I will grant peace in the land</b> So you may lie down <b>with none to frighten you.</b> <b>I will remove dangerous animals from the land;</b></p> <p>7 Nor will the sword pass through your land.
