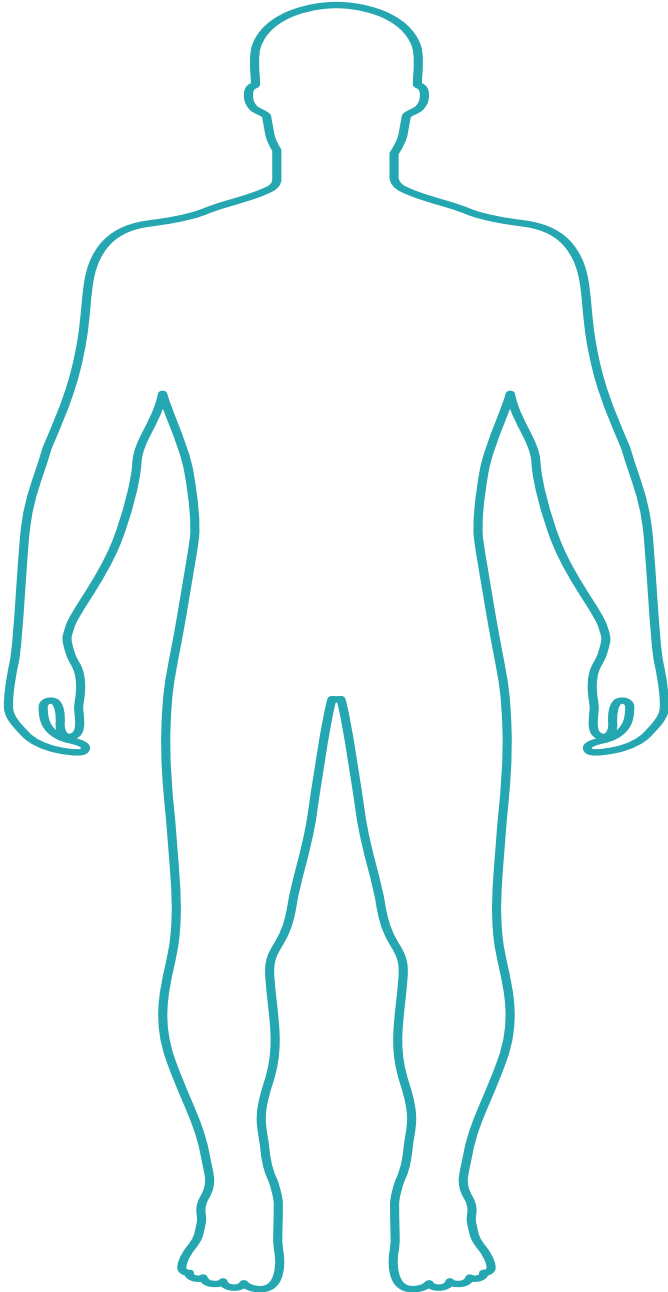
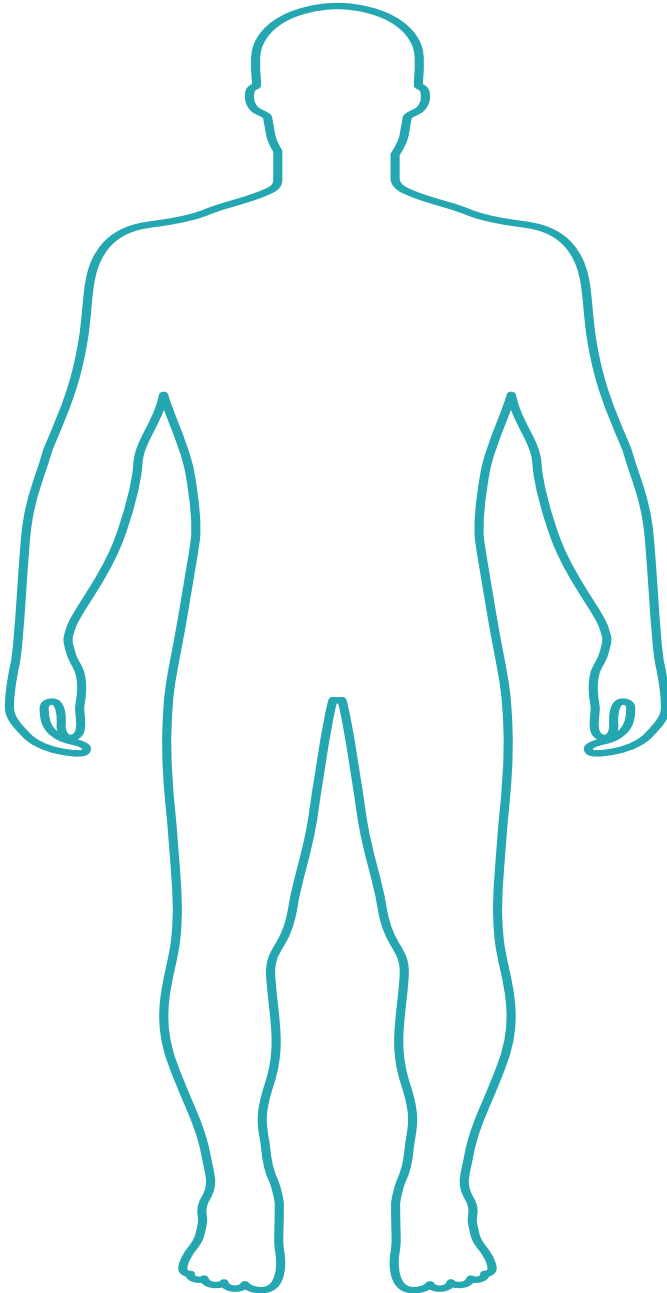


On the figure below, draw the most ridiculous, disgusting outfit you can imagine. Think of something you would never wear in public and draw it.
