



Jesus of Nazareth was the friend of many. He told great stories. He healed sick people and did wonderful miracles.






There was an important festival in Jerusalem. Jesus went with twelve special friends, his disciples.

Jesus was born in a stable in Bethlehem.




Later, he went to live with his parents, Joseph and Mary, in Nazareth. When Jesus was twelve, his parents took him to Jerusalem.
